## FIRST DISTRICT UPDATE

Lakeland Village 8/24/22

<u>Maiden Lane:</u> Work on Maiden Lane Flood Channel begun July 11, 2022 and is expected to be fully completed on February 15, 2024. The project stared on the water end of Maiden Lane and will continue toward the mountain side of Lakeland Village. It is projected that the project will not affect Grand Avenue and create traffic issues until two to three months from now.

<u>Update on CFD Community Vote?</u>: We previously discussed a potential vote for a Community Finance District (CFD) in Lakeland Village. This CFD was in response to resident requests to explore options to improve community services and/or infrastructure to help fund improvements, such options included Grand Ave. streetlights, sidewalks, crosswalks with flashing lights, Grand Ave. widening or curb & gutters, and/or Community Center, Code Enforcement, and/or enhanced Sheriff Patrol funding. This item will not be on the November Ballot as previous proposed but is still being considered to be put to the people for a vote at a later date to be determined.

<u>Road Slurry Project Grand Ave:</u> Riverside County Transportation has nearly finished its road slurry pavement, resurfacing, striping and delineators installing on Grand Avenue. As you probably have seen Grand Avenue has been resurfaced and restriped. We are waiting for delineators to be added onto Grand Avenue, Riverside County Transportation, indicates the delineators should be installed shortly, citing a "glue shortage" for the delay. A total 27,407 feet or 5.19 miles has been paved on Grand Avenue.

**Infrastructure improvements**: The First District office is pursuing grant and funding to help fund local improvements:

- We are hopeful that on Tuesday's (August 30, 2022) board meeting another round of improvements will be approved. These improvements include paving Gamel, Marvella, and adding a sidewalk and safety improvement to McKay (Behind Community Center). We will use Unincorporated Communities Initiative (UCI) funds.
- 2. We continue to work to get Zinck, Lower Landerville, Crawford, and Custer dirt roads paved. Unfortunately, there has been a delay in Riverside County Transportation but these roads are funded by UCI funds to be paved soon.
