### 4.0 <u>Public Safety and Government Agencies</u>

4.1 Riverside County Sheriff – Deputy Thomas (951) 210-1128:

May yielded 333 calls, 10 arrests; June yielded 326 calls, 4 arrests. Several burglaries reported. Captain Ray Fellows out of the Perris Station provided updates to department staffing with the new Sheriff's management team in place and "No-Grow" marijuana cultivation enforcement in Riverside County. The recent bust yielded 25 tons of plants, 51 guns and 39 arrests. Capt. Fellows provided suggestions to avoid identity theft and suggested contacting www.IC3.gov to file a complain with the FBI in the event of identity theft.

- 4.3 <u>California Highway Patrol Sargent Robles:</u>
